Drama Club

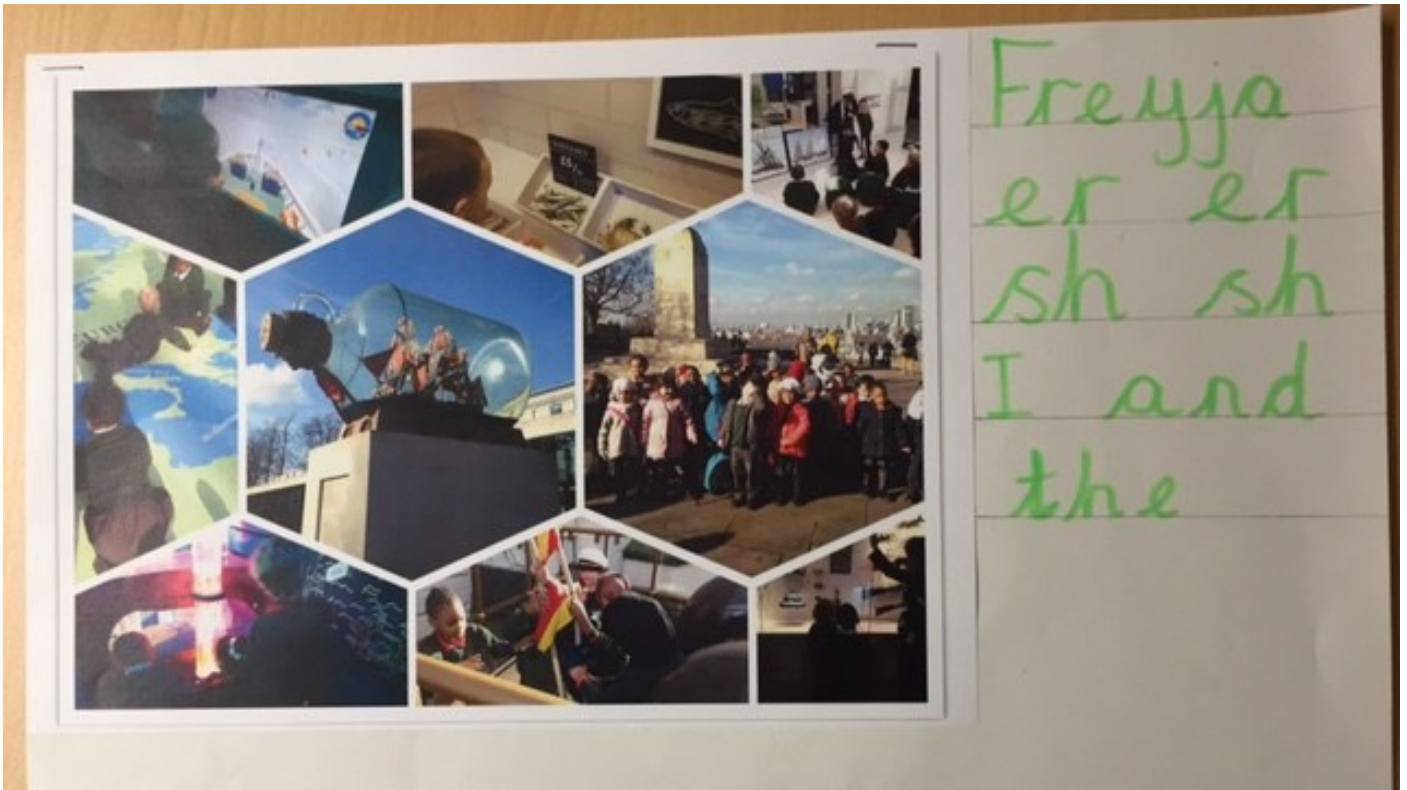

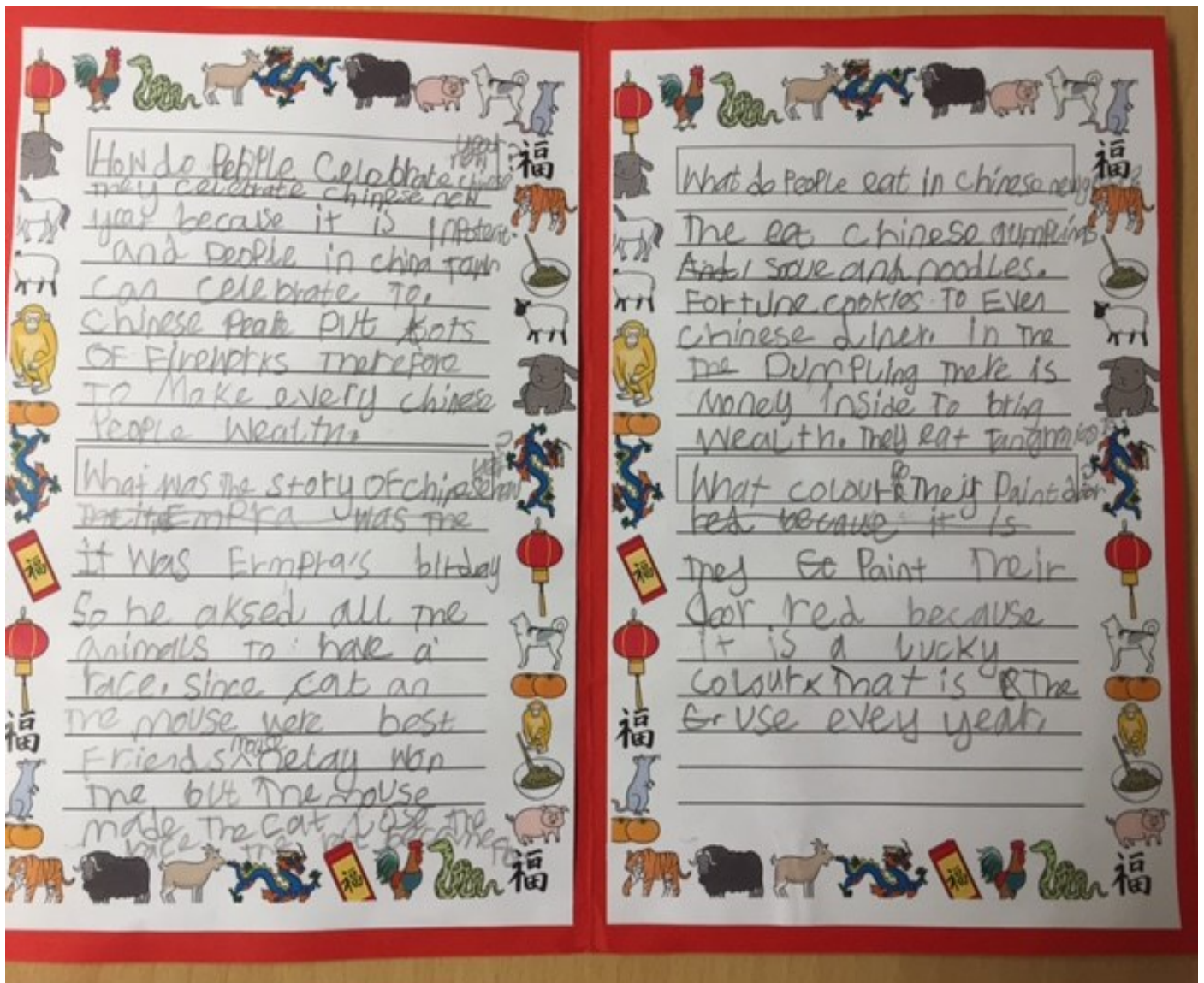

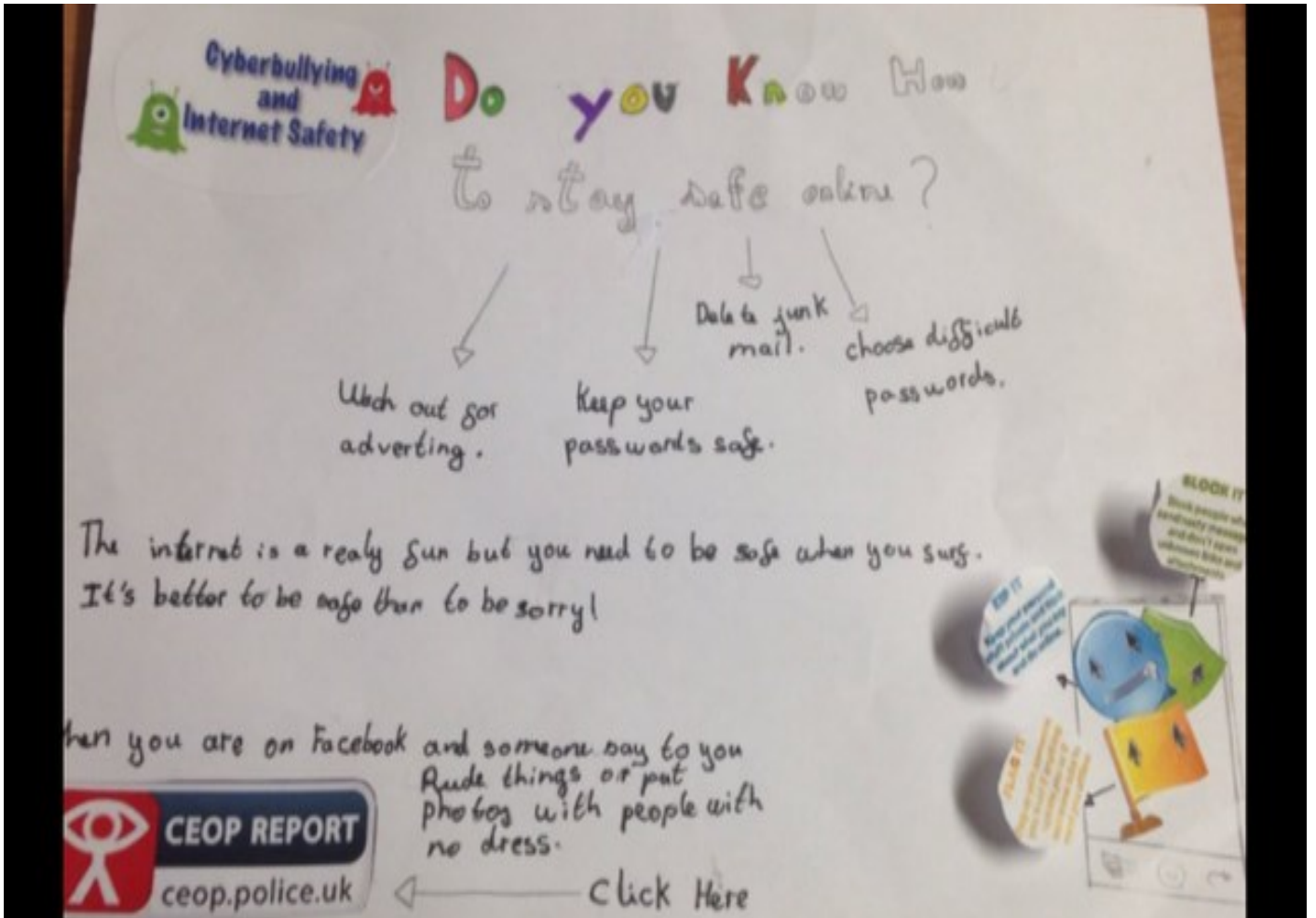


Lime Y1/2 - Big Write - Explanation of how Chinese New Year is celebrated
