Anti-bullying week

Week commencing 13-17th November will be our **whole school 'Anti-bullying week'**. Throughout the week we will be carrying out a range of activities to raise awareness of what bullying is and how we can stop it. **Activities will include:** whole school assembly, creating posters to show what bullying is and how we can stop it (posters will be displayed around the school), creating anti-bullying signs and listening to stories or watching clips about bullying and taking part in role play and creating comic strip, 'Drop everything and read' (**DEAR**) will also take place to help pupils reflect on bullying, making friendships bracelets and learning more about cyber bullying.
