Spring 1 2018- This half term Lower Key Stage 2 (Year 3 and 4) will be learning about the following topics:

English	We will start the term by reading The Iron Man by Ted Hughes . The children will explore the devices of mystery and suspense. They will write a range of different texts-types including letters, a news article and a poem with the extended written outcome being a published narrative. Grammar will be embedded within these literacy sessions. Spelling lists will be sent home on Mondays and tested the following week. We will continue to focus on the Year 3/4 spelling rules and patterns.
Reading Records	The children will bring home a book from the class book corner or the school library at least once a week. Please read and discuss the book with your child. Parents must record in the reading records every time they read at home. Please note that children are required to have their book bag with their reading record inside every day. Children have reading passports , which are kept in school. The children are challenged to read different texts and genres.
Maths	In Numeracy pupils will begin the term by consolidating their number and place value skills, before beginning to learn how to solve addition and subtraction using the expanded written method. We will then be using our knowledge of multiplication to help us solve division. We will solve problems and focus on reasoning using our skills and knowledge. We will also look at properties of 3d shapes and statistics. Please ensure that your child knows number bonds to one hundred and 2,3,4,5,10 times tables and related division facts (1-12) —it is vital that children know these in order to progress in numeracy.
Science	Our topic this half term is Rocks. We will be grouping and classifying different types of rocks, finding out what soil is made of, learning how fossils are made and researching the life of famous scientist Mary Anning.
Computing	We will be using the internet safely and critically to research a variety of topics.
IPC	This term our IPC theme will be 'Vikings' This is a history topic in which we will learn who the Vikings were, where and how they lived and why they invaded and raided Britain. We will use a variety of different sources and artefacts to help us learn about the lives of the Vikings.
Design & Technology	We will be designing and building a model Viking longship.

P.E.	Cedar will continue to have PE on a Friday and have an additional session on Tuesday . Please ensure that your child/children has the following kit for both PE sessions: Black tracksuit bottoms, a white t-shirt and black trainers or plimsolls. We are welcoming a new coach to the Sports team. P.E. will now be facilitated by Shakil Miah & Miss Macdonald .
Music	LKS2 will have ukulele lessons from a specialist teacher. Singing in class and in assembly also form part of our music curriculum.
R.E.	This term our focus will be Judaism. We will be learning about the Jewish Way of Life.
Modern Languages	Spanish will continue to be taught by our specialist teacher.
P.S.H.E. & Citizenship	Our focus this half term will be "Dreams and Goals"
Homework	A variety of cross curricular homework tasks will be assigned at the start of the half term. Each week your child will select one task to complete, to be returned by Tuesday. Children should continue to learn their times tables , which will be tested on a regular basis. Children can practice using Timestable Rockstars, for which they have their own login. Additional maths homework will be assigned on the Mathletics website, for which each child also has their own username and password. Children should also learn spellings which will be sent home every week and tested the following week.
