

## Hollydale Primary School

Welcome back to Spring term and the countdown to SATS! We hope you have had a restful Christmas and are ready for all the exciting and challenging opportunities this term will offer!

We begin this new term with lots of exciting topics for the children to become immersed in. For our History topic, we will be immersing ourselves into the fascinating Shang Dynasty, just in time for Chinese New year on February the 5<sup>th</sup>. To celebrate this, the children will be taking part in a dragon dance workshop on Friday the 8<sup>th</sup> February, and this will be free of charge.

During the Spring term your children will be preparing all year for their end of KS2 assessments (SATS). These will take place on the week of the 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2019. To help prepare for this the children in school, they will be having weekly Maths Fluency, spelling, grammar and timetables practise to ensure they are fully prepared and confident! As well as this, they will be having weekly homework to ensure they are progressing so please support your child with this throughout the year!

### **Spring 2019- This half term KS2 (Y5 & Y6) will be learning about the following topics:**

<b>English</b>	In year 6 the children will be basing their learning on the book, 'The Lost Thing'. They will be writing recounts and instructions based on new inventions. They will also be having reading lessons where they will be practising the skills needed for reading comprehension due to their upcoming SATS.
<b>Reading Records</b>	Since the beginning of the year the children have been bringing home a book from the book corner every day. Each day we record who has written in and handed in their reading records. Please read and discuss the book with your child and ensure that it is returned each day. The reading books will be changed for Willow, on Fridays and Hazel on Tuesdays. Rewards will be given to children for fantastic, in-depth comments.
<b>Spelling, punctuation and grammar</b>	This term, the children will be having weekly grammar sessions in order to improve their understanding of the grammatical conventions of the English language. We will be looking specifically at grammatical conventions linked to our text types whilst keeping up our basic skills. The children will also have weekly spelling sessions where we will teach them explicit spelling rules, which will then be applied in the weekly spelling homework. Spelling tests of these words will take place on <b>Thursdays</b> .
<b>Maths</b>	In Maths the children will be focusing and revision key subjects such as decimals, data, statistics and algebra. They will need to ensure they complete their weekly Mathematics homework which will consolidate this learning. The children will also be taking part in weekly revision classes in Maths where they will be revising key subjects of division, fractions, converting and time.
<b>Science</b>	In Science we will be looking at Light! The children will discover how light travels through conducting their own enquiries and experiments. They will learn that we are able to see objects which have reflected light or emitted light. As always, the children will be developing their "working scientifically" skills, through asking questions and designing tests.
<b>History</b>	This term we will be learning all about The Shang Dynasty. They will be going on an exciting journey back in time to ancient China and learning about the different aspects of day to day life, looking at artefacts found in tombs, learning about the ancient gods and telling their fortunes!
<b>Art</b>	In art this half term we will focus on Shang Dynasty art work, we look at patterns and illustrations and sketch pottery from the era and then design and create our own Shang Dynasty inspired vases using modroc.
<b>P.E.</b>	PE days for Willow class are now just on <b>Thursday</b> . Please ensure that your child/children have the following kit for PE: Black tracksuit bottoms or shorts, a white t-shirt or top and black trainers or plimsolls. This half term the children will be focusing on hockey skills and gymnastics. They will be working on choosing when to pass or dribble, so that they keep possession and make progress towards the goal and use attacking and defending skills appropriately in games. In gymnastics they will be working making up longer sequences and perform them with fluency and clarity of movement, and, with a partner or a small group practising and refining a sequence.
<b>Music</b>	Children will take part in weekly Brass lessons on Thursday.
<b>R.E.</b>	This term RE will be focusing on the importance of different leaders in religion. The children will be looking at what makes a good leader and how they can become on themselves.
<b>P.S.H.E. &amp; Citizenship</b>	This term our focus will be on setting targets for ourselves. The children will take part in weekly circle times where they will be able to discuss any thoughts and feelings they have about their upcoming exams or transition into secondary school.
<b>Homework</b>	The children need to complete their maths homework via Mathletics (mathletics.com) Each child has their own individual log on which has been sent home. For reading, they will complete a weekly task on First

	news, and times tables on Times table rock stars. With their impending exams, teachers may set individual homework based on the lesson. If your child receives this, please ensure that they complete and return the next day. All other homework is due on <b>Tuesdays</b> .
